The Muskegon County Road Commission in cooperation with the Michigan Department of Transportation has scheduled a road improvement project on **Giles Road from Scenic Drive to Whitehall Road** in Laketon Township, Muskegon County

The contractor has informed the Road Commission that work should begin August 5, 2019 with anticipated completion date on or prior to November 15, 2019. The 5-mile project will consist of road cross-culvert replacements, intersection work, cold-in-place recycling of the existing road surface, hot mix asphalt surface paving, shoulders, approaches and other necessary related work.

For safety and overall speed of project completion, the road will be closed during construction. It is, however, a condition of the contract that emergency vehicles and residents living within the construction area are able to get to and from their homes. The posted detour will consist of Scenic Drive, River Road, and Whitehall Road.

As we must work along the shoulders, intersection curbs and adjacent areas please note: If you have sprinklers or other landscaping features within the road right-of-way, please relocate those items to a location outside the right-of-way prior to construction. In general, the right-of-way line is 33 feet from the center of the road in most locations along Giles Road.

If we need to temporarily relocate your mailbox during the project our inspector will let you know the location where your mail can be picked up.

If you have any critical health condition or other special condition, which you feel we should be made aware of, please feel free to contact the Muskegon County Road Commission.

We are hoping this letter will allow you time to prepare for this upcoming project and plan for any particular needs/concerns you may have.
