

**Laketon Township Planning Commission  
Public Hearing Minutes of March 16, 2010**

- A. Call to Order: Chairperson John McDonnell called the meeting to order at approximately 6.01 PM.
- B. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.
- C. Roll Call: Members present were Cindy Zaagman, Lynn Stel, Mary Marcil, John McDonnell, Bob Schalow, Eric Anderson and Cindy Ackerman. Members absent: None. Also present were Township Supervisor Kim Arter, Township Zoning Administrator Dick Grenell, Township Building Inspector Rod Siegel, Recording Secretary Veronica West and three area citizens.
- D. Introduction: Planning Commission Chairperson John McDonnell gave a brief introduction and explained the purpose of the meeting was to receive public comment on proposed zoning ordinance amendments. Mr. McDonnell also noted the proposed amendment regarding Wind Energy Conversion Systems was removed from the list of proposed amen and will not be included in this meeting but will be revisited at a later date.
- E. Chairperson John McDonnell gave instructions as to how the meeting would be conducted. He also explained that if anyone desired to speak they must give their name and address and keep the comments and questions concise and to the point.
- F. Chairperson John McDonnell opened the public hearing. Mr. McDonnell went through each proposed amendment and summarized each one. There were no public questions, concerns or comments made.

Cindy Zaagman supported the motion. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
- I. Motion for Adjournment: Mary Marcil moved to adjourn the meeting. Lynn Stel supported the motion. The motion carried by voice vote and the meeting adjourned at 6:17 pm.
